

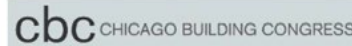
## ABOUT REBUILDING TOGETHER

In the spirit of volunteerism and community partnership, Rebuilding Together Metro Chicago improves the homes and neighborhoods of elderly, disabled and low-income residents so that they may continue to live in warmth, safety and comfort.

Rebuilding Together Metro Chicago was formed in 1991 to improve the declining housing stock and neighborhoods in Chicago and Cook County. Rebuilding Together serve existing homeowners who, due to financial or physical limitations, have been unable to adequately maintain their homes.

After 24 years, Rebuilding Together repaired over 1,500 homes and 200 nonprofit facilities in partnership with communities, corporations, trade unions and civic groups.

Give Back Days are hands-on, volunteer-driven days of service. Each project is tailored to the sponsoring group's size, skill level and budget. Typical projects include painting, landscaping, organizing & cleaning, painting murals, furniture & playground assembly, and other minor repairs.

To date, Give Back Day sponsors and volunteers have worked to improve over 200 community facilities in Chicagoland!

All work is completed in one day, allowing volunteers to see their immediate impact. It's an outstanding opportunity for colleagues to work together outside of the office and make a real difference. Team-building is an exciting by-product of a Give Back Day.
