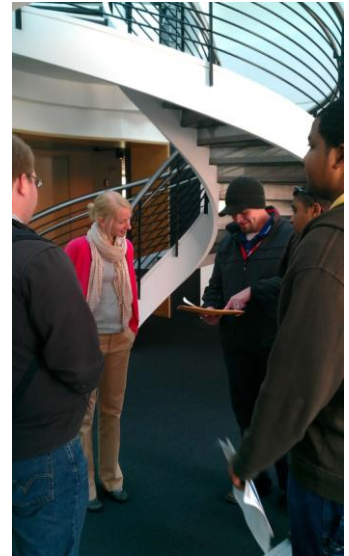

### Certification News

The Chicago Chapter will be conducting its highly-acclaimed and extremely successful CDT certification classes starting January 9, 2012 in preparation for the March/April exam. Alan B. Itzkowitz, AIA, CSI, CCS, CCCA, NCARB, LEED AP is the chair of this year's program and will enlist some of the brain trust of the chapter as instructors. Although this course is structured to prepare students for the CDT exam, many architects and other design and construction professionals have benefits from the wealth of knowledge contained in the course. Priority for the class is given to members. 15.0 AIA/LU's are given for those attending 8 of the 10 classes. ### CCCA Certification Candidates Now Required to Have Two Years of Experience

At the recommendation of the Certification Committee, the board revised the experience prerequisite for Certified Construction Contractor Administrator candidates from "strongly encouraged" to a requirement attested to by two people. Implementation of this modification will align the advanced certification exam candidate prerequisites and enhance the CCCA credential.

CCCA candidates registering for the spring 2012 exam will be the first group that will have to meet this requirement.

**HOW TO UPDATE YOUR ADDRESS ONLINE AT WWW.CSINET.ORG**

1. Go to CSINet ([www.csinet.org](http://www.csinet.org)) and log in through the box on the right of the home page. You can also log in on any other page; look for the box on the left.

To log in, you'll need your CSINet username and password. If you are visiting for the first time, you must log in with the Username that has been preset for you.

The login is:

Username: `firstname@lastname` (ie `John@Smith`)

Password: Your CSI Member ID number

Your Member ID can be found on your CSI membership card or above your name on the Construction Specifier mailing label.
